Program Overview

Care & Aim Network for Humanity is comprised of activators and volunteers who are passionate about making a difference. Thematic Areas of Activities

Sensitization and awareness campaigns: We conduct awareness campaigns within the community on wastewater management, preventative care, and the importance of clean water and a green environment.

Highlights of the CAN4H Outreach Activities

Below are some of the activities and works we have carried out as Care and Aim Network for Humanity to show love, care, and support

Building A Police Station In A Community-Rosedale Police Station-2016

In 2016, CAN for Humanity Collaborated with key stakeholders in the community to help resolve the increasing crime rates in the Lusaka-West area by building a police station to ensure that crime rates were reported and security was maintained. It was a great concern that directly affected the businesses in the community and the population. The setup of the police station was important as it helped to address and reduce not just the crime rate but also, timely reports of rape and domestic violence cases.



HOUSE OF HOPE-2016

House of Hope Zambia is an organization supporting orphans, the vulnerable, widows, and the underprivileged in society. House of Hope Africa works to holistically improve the lives of vulnerable women, children, and families living in impoverished areas. This is achieved through combined efforts by every member of society offering any form of help to those in need. Through providing advocacy, education, and training, the team forms integral relationships within the community, empowering individuals to grow and fulfill the purpose and destiny God has for their lives.

Orphanage visit

CAN for Humanity strongly believes in giving back to the community, especially the orphaned, minority, and marginalized in society who need additional support and care. CAN For Humanity paid a visit to the orphanages for abused and raped victims in Lusaka. During the visit to the orphanages, we noted the different challenges faced by orphans and their caregivers in access to health care, food, school fees, books and sanitary kits for the girl child, and basic life essentials such as soap, tissues and lotions

At the end of the visit, CAN for Humanity offered a scholarship to one of the students to attend university so that she could fulfill her dream. During the engagement with the kids, we emphasized that life is not defined by the past nor does it end after being raped or abused, there is more to life and what happened in that past should not hold anyone from working towards their dream.







KEEP LUSAKA CLEAN CHAMPAIGN-2017

The Ministry of Local Government implemented the 'Keep Zambia Clean and Healthy" campaign, a behavior change program aimed at keeping surroundings in Zambia clean, healthy, and green to improve the health standards of Zambians throughout the country.

In 2017, Care and Aim Network for Humanity participated in the Keep Zambia Clean and Healthy Campaign by cleaning the surrounding communities; the streets and unblocking clogged gutters and drainage ditches along the roads.

World Water Day at Chilenje Hospital Maternity Ward

The Chilenje Hospital Maternity Ward, similar to other government health facilities faces shared challenges such as limited resources and under-staffing which influence the quality and type of care provided that affect the diagnosis, and treatment of care including referral of emergency cases to the national hospital.

CAN 4 Humanity supported by Fairy Bottling visited the Chilenje Maternity Wards to donate mineral bottled water to the mothers in the maternity wards in commemoration of World Water Day 2017 under the theme "Wastewater".

Pediatric visit at the UNIVERSITY TEACHING HOSPITAL

The University Teaching Hospital (UTH) is the largest public hospital in Zambia located in the capital city of Lusaka approximately 4 km east of the city centre. UTH is the principal medical training institution in the country for medical students, interns, and postgraduate doctors and within it, a nursing training school for nurses. The University Teaching Hospital (UTH) represents a remarkable reflection of the health system in Zambia and the complex institution serves as the referral centre for all complicated medical conditions.

CAN 4 Humanity supported by Fairy Bottling visited the 10 Pediatric Children's Wards at UTH and donated bottled water to all 10 children's wards. Led by Mr. Mwiche Chipaya, the Customers Relations Officer, the team spent the day with the kids in the pediatric ward followed by a discussion on how CAN for Humanity can further support the pediatric wing at the hospital.









Special Olympics Zambia

Special Olympics is an organization established in 1968 and works worldwide with athletes with intellectual and physical disabilities using thousands of volunteers and coaches each year. Since its establishment, the number of volunteers and people without intellectual disabilities organization has been growing at a fast pace. Special Olympics Zambia is a program aimed at changing the lives of persons with intellectual disabilities through the power of sports training and athletic competition in a variety of Olympic-type sports for children and adults by giving them continued opportunities to develop physical fitness, demonstrate courage, experience joy and participate in sharing gifts, skills, and friendship with their families, other Special Olympics athletes and the community as a whole.

The main attractions of this event are:

It was an honor for Care and Aim Network for Humanity to participate in the events by providing refreshments and funding for Volunteer's transportation and allowances.

Care and Aim Network for Humanity CAN4H powered by Fairy Bottling partnered with Zambian and International Designers to organize an exclusive fashion show under the theme "Empowering Diversity" and had models from different backgrounds including those with disability. The guest of honor was the renowned international designer Tarek Sinno. The fashion event was designed with an innovative approach to mirror the international fashion shows to boost morale and spark creativity among the fashion designers in attendance while giving the models an international feel-experience as a model with the hope to motivate them to continue to pursue their modeling career.

During the event, two dresses donated by international designers were auctioned and all donations and proceeds were donated to the Esther Lungu Foundation. Tarek Sinno, our guest of honor, also conducted a 3 day fashion design workshop to upcoming local designers.

CAN For Humanity COVID -19 Initiatives.

During the early stages of the COVID-19 outbreak in 2020, when the World Health Organization (WHO) announced it as a global pandemic, CAN For Humanity collaborated with Medland Hospital to provide education and awareness about COVID-19. This included information on how individuals, families, and communities can prevent and manage the virus.

CAN For Humanity shares the same principles and values as Medland Hospital, which centers around the idea that we can achieve more when we work together. As a result, they formed partnerships and collaborations to increase awareness, educate and sensitize the community about COVID-19, and share relevant materials. With Medland Hospital's support, CAN For Humanity facilitated COVID-19 screening, testing, and vaccination through Q-Medland Clinics that were donated to the community. This made COVID-19 services more accessible to the community.

The Future

Our mandate is to continue our call to action by offering support for the less privileged in society through health care and education support systems. We seek to establish partnerships with organizations and stakeholders with similar interests to advocate for a policy review to address youth and gender issues. We believe that through collaboration, we can create a world that is more equitable and just, where every individual has access to the resources and support they need to reach their full potential.

Our goal is to support the less privileged in society, specifically women, children, and youth, by providing them with healthcare and education assistance. In addition, we are committed to promoting a healthy environment and have launched a program to improve access to clean water and environmental sanitation.

Below are some future activities and projected prospects that could be undertaken:

Education and Training Programs

- Develop and implement leadership training programs for women and youth in target communities, focused on building skills such as communication and problem-solving.
- Establish partnerships with local educational institutions to provide scholarships and vocational training opportunities to young women and girls.

Advocacy

- Collaborate with local and national policymakers to advocate for policies that protect the rights of women and children, such as anti-discrimination laws, child protection policies, and gender-based violence prevention measures.
- Develop and implement public education campaigns to raise awareness about the importance of protecting women's and children's rights in the community.

Small and Medium-Sized Enterprise Development

- •Establish small business incubators in target communities, providing training and resources to help entrepreneurs start and grow successful businesses.
- Provide microfinance loans to support the growth of small businesses owned by women and youth.
- Connect small businesses with local and regional markets, helping them to expand their reach and generate more income for the community.



Health Awareness Campaigns and Education

- Collaborate with local healthcare providers and educational institutions to improve access to quality healthcare and education.
- Develop and implement programs to prevent the spread of communicable diseases such as tuberculosis, influenza, and other infectious diseases.
- Develop programs to promote healthy lifestyle choices such as regular exercise, healthy eating, and stress reduction techniques.
- Develop and implement public education campaigns to raise awareness about the importance of preventive healthcare, healthy lifestyle choices, and disease prevention.

Comprehensive Complementary Healthcare Services

- Develop and implement programs to provide complementary healthcare services to the community, including services such as acupuncture, chiropractic, massage therapy, and other alternative therapies.
- Establish partnerships with local healthcare providers and government agencies to provide vaccination programs and other preventive healthcare services.
- Develop programs to provide home-based complementary healthcare services to individuals who cannot travel to healthcare facilities due to mobility issues, transportation limitations, or other barriers.

- Collaborate with government and other organizations to address issues related to women's and children's rights and access to sexual reproductive health.
- Partner with local health organizations to provide training and resources to community health workers, enabling them to provide more effective prevention and treatment services.
- Establish partnerships with local schools and community organizations to provide health education workshops and programs to students and community members.

By focusing on these areas, Care & Aim Network for Humanity can continue to work towards its mission of empowering women and youth, protecting women and children's rights, creating sustainable livelihood opportunities, promoting health awareness, equity, and prevention, and creating a world where marginalized communities have access to the resources they need to thrive.
